"G FORCE DRIVER DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM" Launches

Growing Talented Teenage Racing Drivers with G Force Engineering -Two Selections from Oceania, One from Switzerland for this season-

G Force Engineering, led by President and CEO Masaru Okazawa, is set to launch the G FORCE DRIVER DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM aimed at nurturing junior drivers to hone their talents as racing drivers and step up to a higher level of international racing stage.

In the 2024 program, three drivers have been selected: Sebastian Manson from New Zealand, Jesse Lacey from Australia, and Michael Sauter from Switzerland. They will compete in the 2024 FORMULA REGIONAL JAPANESE CHAMPIONSHIP (FRJ).

While the three drivers will be divided into two teams for entry, Masaru Okazawa, representing G Force Engineering, will take the helm as supervisor, drawing from his extensive experience as a member of Team Goh in numerous international races including the Le Mans 24 Hours, as well as his achievements in domestic top-tier categories like SUPER GT and SUPER FORMULA.

Driving coaching will be provided by Seiji Ara, a Le Mans winner who continues to excel in events like SUPER GT, while Hiroshi Yuchi, a renowned racing car designer and engineer in Japan, will serve as the chief engineer. Leveraging exceptional engineering expertise developed in international racing, G Force Engineering aims to provide various approaches to equip teenage drivers competing in mid-level formula races with the necessary elements for advancement.

The FRJ season will kick off with pre-season joint testing at Suzuka on February 21, where Sebastian and Jesse will make their debut on Japanese circuits. Two weeks later, on March 9-10, the FRJ opening weekend will feature three races at Suzuka Circuit, marking the beginning of the 2024 season and setting the stage for Sebastian, Jesse, and Michael's battles on Japanese circuits.

BORN TO RACE

Jesse's racing heritage runs deep as a third-generation racer. Born into the Lacey family, which boasts a storied history in Speedway racing, including multiple Australian championships, his destiny was always to be on the racetrack. His racing journey commenced in 2016 when he was just 9 years old, and remarkably, in his debut year, he clinched the Australian Karter of the Year award in the Cadet 9 category. Fast forward six years, and Jesse took on the world's finest drivers, emerging victorious. His international racing debut in October 2019 saw him rise above 150 competitors, securing pole position in his first race. Jesse went on to achieve a remarkable triumph by winning the prestigious Sahi Trophy, prevailing over 100 racers hailing from various corners of the globe.

FERRARI DRIVER ACADEMY 2021

In 2021, Jesse was the winner of the Australian and NZ FDA talent search, and as a result he flew to Italy and attended the Ferrari driver academy in October. He competed against 3 other candidates selected from all over the world. The winner would receive a contract with Ferrari in 2022 to drive a Formula Four in the Italy Championship. Jesse was the youngest of the 4 drivers, and the least experienced. While he was not the eventual winner for 2021, he pitted himself extremely well against some incredibly talented young men. The experience was amazing, and it has only made him more committed.
